Correspondence

[1] Church – an application from the church for a portaloo to be install by the porch of the church, it was noted to ask for insurance to be in place, to be locked when not in use and secure safely to building.

[1.1] Housing needs - Council to be invited to a public meeting on the 1 August at the parish room along with Llangwm and Llanfihangel community councils with the housing needs in the area.

[1.2] Welsh water – details of Community Welsh water grant – the clerk to make inquiry for some pot plants for Glasfryn, Cefn Brith, Pentrellyncymer, Cwmpenanner and Yr Alwen.

[1.3] Un named letter – letter of thanks received to thank the council for keeping the cemetery clean and tidy.

[1.4] Haydn Roberts invoice for cutting the grass at Tyn Rhyd and Church cemeteries. £480 was paid.

[1.5] Daniel Rimmer - invoice for servicing the council lawn mower £30.00 was paid.

[1.6] Cadwyn Clwyd - letter stating the no grant was awarded towards re surfacing the path at the new cemetery.

[1.7] Snowdonia Fire Service – the annual service of fire appliance at the parish room £200.70 was paid.

[1.8] Casual Vacancy councilor – a letter of resignation from Trystan Humphreys – the clerk to make necessary arrangement with Conwy Council and advertise the post.

[1.9] Conwy County Council – planning application to remove existing conservatory and replace with orangery - no objections.

[2.0] Foot path – clerk to ask Haydn to cut the grass on the path leading to the A5.

[2.1] 2022/23 Audit - note was given for the councilor to state in a letter to say no expense was taken during the 2023 account.

[2.2] Questioner it was noted that a questioner for the village will be drafted for the future.

[2.3] Cae Llwyd Orchard - it was advised that the cutting of the grass should be left until September/October.

[2.4] New cemetery - it was noted the some trees need cutting and trimming at the cemetery. The clerk to contact John Appleby for advice.
