[1.6] Hiraethog Development Strategy

Eirian Roberts the Strategy Co-ordinator was welcomed to the meeting and explained regarding the financial opportunities available once the Innogy Company had completed the wind turbine programme in the Clocaenog Forest

Apparently £750,000 a year will be available for a period of 25 years to the Hiraethog area and emphasised the importance of drawing up proposals as soon as possible which will be of benefit to the area.
