Matters Arising

[1] Police Matters

The clerk advised that the Police were unable to be present and that there were no reports of any local issues. Clerk to respond advising of a number of sheep missing from a local farm along with the theft of a motorcycle from a farm at Cwmpenanner.

[1.1] Future of the Library

The clerk reported that the building had been refurbished and was now open. Clerk to draw attention of the Library Support Group of the need of a sign advertising the service.

The clerk referred to correspondence from Aled Roberts AM seeking views regarding speed limits on the A5 trunk road. Resolved to respond as follows:

- [b] Glasfryn – There is a need to introduce a 40mph restriction noting a very busy junction leading to the main road along also with the public having to cross to access the footway.
