Correspondence

[1] Glorious Gravel Cycling event – were noted for an event on 25th of April.

[1.1] Bodtegir wind farm applications - application were submitted for grant. £11,000 received towards the toilets architectural work and admin costs. The planting of hedge in the cemetery was unsuccessfully this time due to the number of application received for grant.

[1.2] Parish Room windows - a quote received for changing three windows at parish room were noted and the clerk to have another quotation to compare price.

[1.3] Conwy Borough council – grant received for £660.00 towards the Warm Hub at the White Lion for the months of October, November and December.

[1.4] White Lion – an invoice for £660.00 received for the hire and the food for the Warm Hub for the months of January, February and March was paid.

[1.5] Plus net – and invoice received from the clerk for £22.99 towards the internet connection at Parish Room the clerk was paid with future invoiced coming from the community council accounts by direct debit.

[1.6] Hufenfa De Arfon - it was note the application for a diffu at the Caravan Park in Pentrelynicymer has been successful with no forthcoming cost from the community council for its upkeep.

[1.7] Scottish power - and invoice for £26.332 was paid by DD

[1.8] Bryson Recycling - the annual subscription for the 4 green was bins at the 2 cemeteries £124.00 was paid by the clerk - community council to pay back the clerk.

[1.9] One voice wales - annually subscription £157.00 was paid.

[2.] Cll Gwennol Ellis report – it was noted that Conwy B Council will raise their council tax by 6.09% and 0.31% for fire Service. The foot path will be in place by the Bwyd a Ni and the firestation by the end of the month. Grant availability were note and clerk to make enquiries.

[2.1] Flower pots at the square in the village – Menai Hughes has kindly planted some flowers and cleaning substances were bought for the Parish £23.29 was paid.

[2.2] The Accountant - The hire fee for the use of the Parish Room for Accountancy will be raised to £900.00 for last year hiring and it was passed that it would be best for the hire to be paid on a quarterly basis from now on at £250.00 per quarter.

[2.3] Parking out side the school – the parking is still a big concern, with the safety of parent collecting their children from school as there is a high volume of cars parked outside the school entrance. Cll Gwennol Ellis to hold a meeting with school governors, community councillors and Conwy Council representative to see if something can be improved.
