Correspondence

[1] Internal Audit – audit has been completed by Emyr Mortimer and have been approved by the Community council, and signed by the chairperson. Account will be sent to Audit Wales for final auditing.

[1.1] Fit Conwy - no funding needed from community council this year as sufficient funding is in place.

[1.2] Kids with Cancer - letter asking for a donation - none given.

[1.3] Clocaennog wind farm - Grant given for the sum of £50,000 towards renovation of public toilets in the village.

[1.4] Marc Roberts - invoice for grant work £1,080.00 was paid.

[1.5] Haydn Roberts – invoice for the cutting of grass at Tyn Rhyd and the Church cemetery £670.00 was paid (three months work)

[1.6] Scottish power -invoice for £26.32 was paid DD

[1.7] Emyr Mortimer – invoice for internal auditing £480.00 was paid.

[1.8] Emyr Mortimer – engagement letter for internal auditing by Emyr Mortimer were signed by the chairperson for records.

[2.4] Conwy Council – payment for the warm hub £660.00

[2.5] Cadwyn Clwyd - payment of £9,900 grant funding from Brenig wind farm (an extra10% released after completion of work)

[2.6] Cemetery fee - grave stone for the late Bryn Roberts, £50.00, the burial of the late Brenda Jones £150.00, the late Hefin Edwards £400.00, and the late Ifor Davies £400.00.

[2.7] Planning applications – Agricultural shed at Fron Heulog - no objections (cll Gwennol Ellis did not take part in this discussion.)

[2.8] Cll Gwennol Ellis. Noted that the road from Glasfryn to Cefn Brith has been tarmac and for any further road issued to inform Gwennol to pass on to Conwy Council.
